

Summer Ministry Support Worker

PURPOSE: To serve Regent Park and surrounding communities through community involvement, strategically-programmed outreach, caring for members of these communities and providing general support to the ongoing mission of Church in Regent Park.

REPORTING: The **Summer Ministry Support Worker** will receive supervision from the Lead Pastor and other Pastoral Team Members.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide leadership and support to ministries of CIRP
- Assist with serving and caring for approximately 250 people each Saturday at Regent Park Community Dinners
- Assist with planning and organization of Community Dinners
- Assist with the organization and facilitation of Saturday & Sunday services, including assisting with worship, sound & a/v and/or Children's Ministry, based on own skill set
- Provide leadership and support to Children's ministry at the Church in Regent Park
- Provide leadership and support to Lifegroup ministry and Summer Activities at the Church in Regent Park
- Plan, organize, and facilitate weekly activities for children/youth/YA's programs, based on own skill set
- Assist with filming of welcome, announcement and service videos
- Assist with the setup and clean-up of Community Dinners
- Support church attenders, community members, and children/youth to offer community and encouragement (ie helping with technology concerns)
- Provide general assistance to the Lead Pastor and Pastoral Team, as required
- Assist with social networking and website maintenance
- Research community demographics and trends

REQUIREMENTS:

- A strong, passionate belief in the mission, vision and values of CIRP
- Flexible work schedule, including a willingness to work weekends and evenings
- Ability to interact confidentially with community members, children and youth
- Previous experience giving leadership to volunteers
- Previous experience working/volunteering in a church setting is an asset
- Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident and between the age of 15-30 years old as required by the Canada Summer Jobs Grant

CONTRACT LENGTH & HOURS:

The Summer Ministry Support Worker position has been approved for an 8 week contract with 35 hours per week @ at least \$17.60 an hour, but consideration will be given to candidates with a significant amount of experience. The successful applicants will be expected to maintain a flexible schedule, including working evenings and weekends.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- 1. be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period**

2 be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment

3 and have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations
